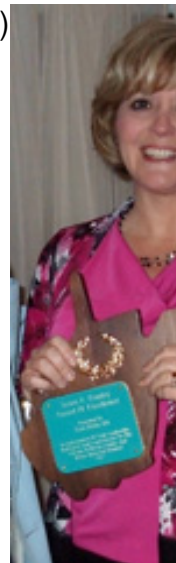


## 2012 James F Trusley Employee of the Year Award Terri Dolin
